In addition to cases which have been reported I have acted in a number of substantial cases which have not been reported. These include *Viridi v Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis*, *Daniel v Chief Constable of Warwickshire Police* (a 35 day sex discrimination case) *B v Ministry of Defence* (ET 2003, acting for a former RAF Flight Lieutenant in a successful sex discrimination claim) and *Phelps v Finance Wales Investments Ltd* (successful defence of a £1m plus whistleblowing claim, Bristol ET).
