James has appeared in many cases related both to the NHS and to community care, including **R (F) v Buckinghamshire County Council** (2019) EWHC 1817 (Admin) on closure of children's centres and consultation.

Recent cases include **R (Lancashire County Council) v SoS for Health and Social Care** (2021) EWHC 268 (Admin), (2021) 24 CCLR 57, dispute between two local authorities as to which of them had responsibility for funding accommodation for an individual who had suffered brain damage.

Challenge to a determination of an "ordinary residence" dispute, i.e. which local authority is responsible for a person. The case was the first test of the "Greenwich principle": the principle by which, if a local authority should have taken particular steps but failed to take them, ordinary residence and responsibility is determined on the presumed factual basis that the local authority had in fact taken those steps.
