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Aliya's practice spans commercial, employment, public and human rights, data protection, sport, and public international law. 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## Public and Human Rights

Aliya practises in all areas of public law and human rights, including judicial review proceedings and claims under the Human Rights Act 1998.

Aliya gained considerable exposure to public law and human rights issues as a Judicial Assistant at the Supreme Court. While at the Supreme Court, Aliya was also appointed UK Focal Point to the European Court of Human Rights' Superior Courts' Network, in which capacity she provided assistance to the Strasbourg court on matters of English law.
